Re: Amended Implementation Plan for Matter-20-01676

Dear Secretary Phillips,

In the Matter of the Implementation of the Public Service Law §§ 32, 89-b, 89-1, 91, 216 and General Business Law § 399-zzzzz (Chapter 106 of the Laws of 2021) Regarding Issuing a Moratorium on Utility Terminations and Disconnections of Residential and Small Business Customers during the COVID-19 State of Emergency, the Village of Caledonia submits the following amended plan of implementation.

- The Village of Caledonia has reviewed the PSL and GBL Amendments and followed the guidelines as outlined in the DPS Guidance document dated December 17, 2021.
- The Village of Caledonia will not terminate or disconnect any residential or small business municipal water customers for the nonpayment of bills, taxes or fees for the duration of the COVID19 State of Emergency, or June 30, 2022, whichever is earlier, if the resident has entered into a Deferred Payment Agreement (DPA) with the village.
- The Village of Caledonia will advise its residential and small business customers of the PSL and GBL amendments and of the protections provided to them on each water bill and on the village website: www.villageofcaledonianyny.org, while these protections remain in effect.

- The Village of Caledonia will accept a residential and small business customer's self-certification that the customer has experienced a change in financial circumstances due to the COVID-19 State of Emergency.
- The Village of Caledonia residential and small business customers will be provided with the right to enter into a Deferred Payment Agreement to prevent future termination with no money down, no late fees or penalties.
- The Village of Caledonia has included a copy of the Village of Caledonia proposed Notice to its residential and small business customers.
- Within 30 days of the effective end date (June 30, 2022), the Village of Caledonia will file a final report detailing 1) the number of residential and small business customers using the PSL Amendment protections, 2) the number of Deferred Payment Agreements for the period of December 22, 2021 to June 30, 2022, and 3) the total number of residential and small business disconnections for non-payment for the period of December 22, 2021 to June 30, 2022.
